Create a Furniture-Friendly Home !

- ❄ To give your old, grimy, wooden furniture a glimmering new look, mix equal parts of olive oil, denatured alcohol, gum turpentine, and strained lemon juice. Apply with a soft cloth but don't forget to buff with a clean one.
- ❄ If you are having a stained sofa, use carbonated water or soda water to remove stain on fabric, as they are pH neutral and odourless. Carbonated water works better with food, tannin and oil-based stains.
- ❄ Leather furniture is very sensitive to heat and sun damage. Position it away from windows and also from heat sources such as fireplaces, radiators and central heating vents.
- ❄ Wipe off polish or wax buildup on wooden furniture by dipping a cloth in a diluted solution of white vinegar. If it is scratched anywhere by your pet, use a Q-tip to apply shoe polish of the same colour.
- ❄ In case your bamboo furniture develops a crack due to weather exposure or age, fix it by gently sanding the area with very fine grit sandpaper. Then paste wax smoothly over the area to make up for the color and tone of the wood.
- ❄ To get rid of dirt stains on outdoor plastic furniture, fill quarter of a cup with regular household bleach. Mix in a large bucket of hot water and scrub the furniture. Allow the solution to sit for a few minutes. Then rinse them down with clean water from a garden hose.
- ❄ Avoid draping damp clothes or dishtowels over cabinet doors. The moisture can cause permanent damage to the cabinet's finish, even causing peeling and discoloration.
